A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to eliminate cost-sharing requirements for behavioral health care under TRICARE Reserve Select.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Affordable Mental
5 Health Care for Selected Reserve Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON COST-SHARING FOR BEHAVIORAL**
2 **HEALTH CARE UNDER TRICARE RESERVE SE-**
3 **LECT.**

4 Section 1076d of title 10, United States Code, is
5 amended—

6 (1) by redesignating subsections (e) and (f) as
7 subsections (f) and (g), respectively; and

8 (2) by inserting after subsection (d) the fol-
9 lowing new subsection (e):

10 “(e) **COST-SHARING FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH**
11 **CARE.**—Notwithstanding the cost-sharing requirements
12 under section 1075(c) of this title, a member of a reserve
13 component covered by **TRICARE Reserve Select** under
14 this section shall not be subject to applicable cost-shares
15 or copayment requirements for any behavioral health care
16 covered under **TRICARE Reserve Select**.”.
