Made-In-America Hydropower Bill Signed Into Law by President Trump

U.S. Senators John Fetterman (D-PA) and Steve Daines (R-MN) announced that their *Build More Hydro* bill has been signed into law by President Trump. The bill, S.1020, allows the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) to approve six-year extensions for hydropower projects licensed before 2020.

This extension for our hydro projects keeps domestic energy production in our commonwealth—yet another reminder of the production powerhouse that Pennsylvania has always been. 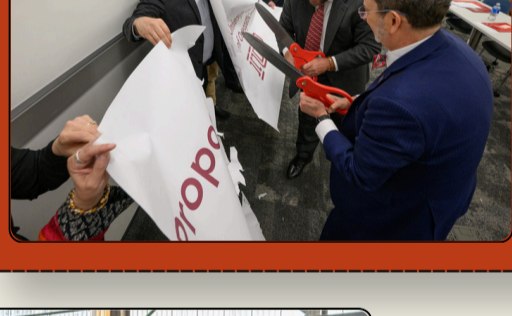

Fetterman Leads Colleagues in Reintroducing Bill to Protect Washington's Trail

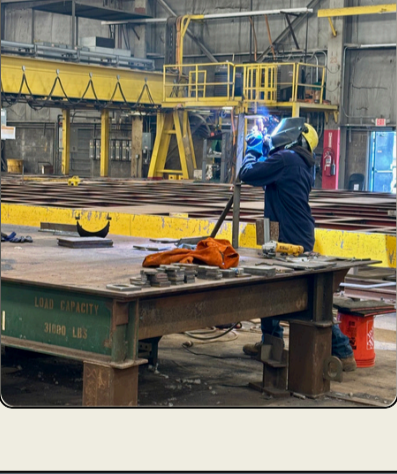

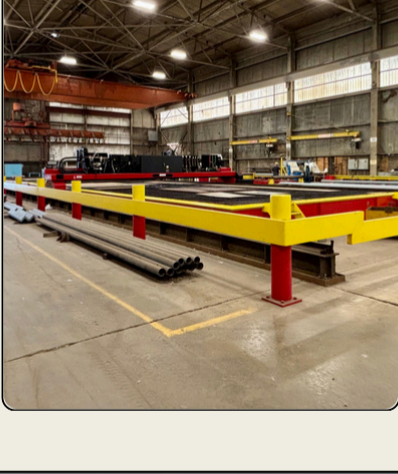
WHAT'S HAPPENING IN THE COMMONWEALTH?



In May, there was an announcement event that showcased how Indiana University of Pennsylvania College of Osteopathic Medicine earned pre-accreditation from the American Osteopathic Association's Commission on Osteopathic College Accreditation. This means that IUP can now open enrollment for the College for the '27-'28 school year. Senator Fetterman has supported the previously proposed College since the beginning of his term through appropriations and advocacy.



Our office toured the Donjon Shipbuilding and Repair facility headquartered in Erie. The company has been a component of Donjon Marine for over half a century and has provided marine salvage, dredging, marine transportation, recycling, demolition, heavy-lift, and other related services. The facility boasts a 1,250 foot dock, which is longer than four football fields. The dry dock is one of only two dry docks on the Great Lakes. The shipyard is located on 44 acre and has more than 200,000 square feet of production area.

CONSTITUENT TESTIMONY

Johnathan H. from Butler County contacted our office for assistance obtaining a Consular Report of Birth Abroad for his son.

"My fiancé gave birth to our son in her native country of the Philippines as we awaited her K-1 Visa. Once our son was born, we attempted to obtain his CRBA (Consular Report of Birth Abroad). We were able to obtain all required documents except for his official government birth certificate, which can take up to a year in the Philippines. If we didn't get his documentation in a timely manner, my fiancé's visa would have expired, and we would have had to do the entire visa process all over again, which would take precious time away from my family and result in over a year of delays.

"I went down several avenues to have the birth certificate requirement waived but to no avail. I was then referred to reach out to Senator Fetterman's Office for assistance. They assisted me within a half hour of my initial email, and the entire process took just a week. Due to the hard work of Senator Fetterman and his office, the birth certificate requirement was waived, and my fiancé and son will be able to come to the United States shortly and reunite my family. Thank you so much to Senator Fetterman and his office for making this happen for us. It would not have been possible without [their] assistance."
